Labour mobility regimes in the European Union can be examined through looking at particular cases of labour rights violations. The general goal of the workshop will be to debate the LABCIT project findings, including specifically our proposed concepts of “Labour Citizenship” and the “lottery of help” that characterize migrant workers labour experiences. We plan to contribute to current discussions on the reconceptualisation of EU mobility, which challenge classical views of migration processes and exploitation of workers (Andrijasevic and Sacchetto 2015; Alberti 2014).
